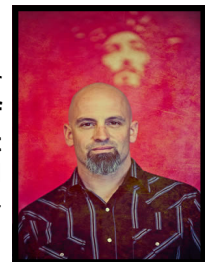


Bob Franquiz

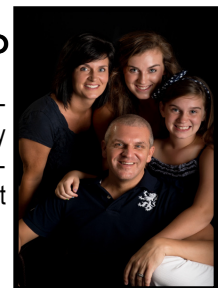


Darrell Parsons

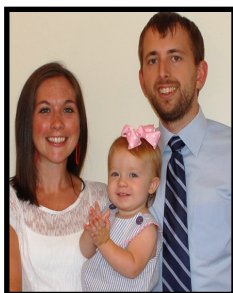


Brett Cooper
