Stuff to Bring

- Closed-toe shoes (for certain activities)

- Towels and washcloths
- Personal hygiene items

Stuff NOT to Bring

- Spaghetti strap tops or small tank tops
- Tight clothes
- "Short" shorts or skirts. (Stand with your arms by your side. If your finger-tips are touching your skin, your shorts or skirt are too short.)
- No "dropped armhole" shirts
- Bikinis or two-piece bathing suits (unless covered with a dark T-shirt)
- Speedos (You'd be surprised)
- Cell phones, iPods, mp3 players or video games**
- Tobacco, drugs, alcohol, or weapons
- Fireworks
- Clothing with questionable sayings, slogans, etc.
